US to limit visa duration for students

The Trump administration is proposing to limit the duration of visas for foreign students and media personnel in the United States.

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) in a press release on Wednesday said that if finalised, the proposed rule would limit the length of time certain visa holders — including foreign students — are allowed to stay in the United States.

Since 1978, foreign students (F visa holders) have been admitted into the US for an unspecified period known as "duration of status".

Unlike other visas issued, those with a "duration of status" designation are allowed to remain in the US for an indefinite amount of time without further screening and vetting, the DHS said.

US to change H1B programme, Green Card process: Lutnick

The Trump administration is planning to change the H1B programme, the most sought after non-immigrant visa among Indian IT professionals and also bring changes to the Green Card process, US Secretary of Commerce Howard Lutnick has said.

"I'm involved in changing the H1B programme. We're going to change that programme, because that's terrible," Lutnick said in an interview to Fox News on Tuesday.

He added that the Trump administration is also going to



The Trump administration said that foreign students have taken advantage of the "US generosity" and have become "forever" students, perpetually enrolled in higher education courses to remain in the country.

"For too long, past administrations have allowed foreign students and other visa holders to remain in the US virtually indefinitely, posing safety risks, costing untold amounts of taxpayer dollars, and disadvantaging US citizens," a DHS

spokesperson said.

"This new proposed rule would end that abuse once and for all by limiting the amount of time certain visa holders are allowed to remain in the US," the spokesperson added.

For foreign media personnel, who can work in the US on an I visa that is issued for five years and can be extended for multiple durations, the rule would set the initial admission period at up to 240 days.

Foreign media representa-

tives would be eligible for an extension period of up to 240 days, but no longer than the length of the temporary activity or assignment.

Under President Trump's proposed rule, the federal government would set the authorised admission and extension periods for foreign students and exchange visitors up to the duration of the programme they are participating in, not to exceed a four-year period.

Additionally, admitting foreign students, exchange, and foreign media classifications for a fixed period of time would require said aliens to apply for authorisation to extend their stay with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, therefore requiring regular assessments by the DHS for the alien to remain in the US for a longer period.

This proposed rule was first proposed under President Trump in 2020 but

was withdrawn by the Biden Administration in 2021.

Separately, the Trump administration is planning to change the H1B programme, the most sought after non-immigrant visa among Indian IT professionals, and also bring changes to the Green Card process, US Secretary of Commerce Howard Lutnick has said.

"I'm involved in changing the H1B programme. We're going to change that programme, because that's terrible," Lutnick said in an interview to Fox News on Tuesday.

The move comes amid a strain in ties between the US and India following the Trump administration imposing 50 per cent tariffs on India for its purchases of Russian oil, which came into effect from Wednesday.

17 killed as floods wreak havoc in Pakistan

At least 17 people have died in the past 24 hours as floods submerged hundreds of villages across Pakistan's Punjab province, officials said on Thursday.

Catastrophic flooding in the Sutlej, Ravi, and Chenab rivers has triggered mass evacuations, damaged infrastructure, and inundated millions of acres of agricultural land in the province of over 130 million people.

According to Punjab Emergency Services Rescue 1122, as many as 17 people died in the floods in the past 24 hours — seven in Sialkot, four in Gujrat, three in Narowal, two in Hafizabad and one in Gujranwala.

Officials said the unusually high water levels in the three rivers were caused by heavy rains combined with excess water released from dams by India. Federal Minister for Development Ahsan Iqbal has accused India of "water aggression".

"India has resorted to water aggression. This is a natural disaster that can only be dealt with through cooperation on both sides of the border. India should have treated it as a natural calamity and worked together with Pakistan, but instead, it suddenly released water in the form of a flood wave, using it as a weapon," he said.

India has opened all the gates of its Thein Dam on the Ravi River, prompting the Punjab administration to call in the Pakistan Army in eight districts — Lahore,

Okara, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Kasur, Sardogha and Hafizabad — of Punjab to assist civil authorities in rescue and relief operations, officials had earlier said.

Pakistan had also received a warning from India that it intends to release water from the rapidly filling Madhopur Dam. Both dams are on the Ravi River, which flows from India into Pakistan.

On Sunday, India communicated flood warnings to Pakistan through diplomatic channels on "humanitarian grounds".

A day after the Pahalgaon terror attack on April 22, India took a series of punitive measures against Pakistan that included putting the Indus Waters Treaty of 1960 in 'abeyance'. Usually, flood alerts are shared through the Indus Water Commission.

According to the Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA), major flood surges are moving downstream, with exceptionally high levels recorded at Khanki and Qadirabad headworks on the Chenab and at Ganda Singh Wala on the Sutlej.

The Ravi at Jassar and Shahdara also remains in high flood, prompting evacuations in parts of Lahore.

The Punjab government, in a statement, said over 250,000 people have been evacuated so far and relief operations are continuing.

Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif and Punjab Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz conducted an aerial survey of flood-hit areas on Thursday.

change the Green Card process that provides permanent residency in the US.

"You know, we give green cards. The average American makes \$75,000 a year, and the average green card recipient \$66,000, so we're taking the bottom quartile, like, why are we doing that? That's why Donald Trump is going to change it. That's the Gold Card that's coming. And we're going to start picking the best people to come into this country. It's time for that to change," he said.

Indians are the main beneficiaries of the H-1B visas, which bring in the best of the talent and brains from across the world.

Highly-skilled professionals from India walk away with the overwhelming number of H-1B visas — which is Congressional mandated 65,000 every year and another 20,000 for those who received higher education from the US.

In a social media post on Tuesday, Lutnick said, "The current H1B visa system is

a scam that lets foreign workers fill American job opportunities.

Hiring American workers should be the priority of all great American businesses. Now is the time to hire American."

Florida Governor Ron DeSantis said in an interview to Fox News that the H1B has become a "total scam".

"These companies game the system. You have some of these companies that are laying off large numbers of Americans while they're also getting new H1Bs and renewing H1Bs," he said.

DeSantis said that people used to say that America is getting the "cream of the crop" from all around the world through the H1B visa system.

"The reality is that's not actually what H1B are. Most of them are from one country, India. There's a cottage industry about how all that people make money off this system."

He said that in the current job market, young Americans are having a much tougher time because of what's happening with AI.

CDC director Susan Monarez fired

The director of the US's top public health agency is out after less than one month in the job and several top agency leaders have resigned.

"Susan Monarez is no longer director of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention. We thank her for her dedicated service to the American people," the US Department of Health and Human Services wrote in a social media post Wednesday.

HHS officials did not explain why Monarez was no longer with the agency.

Before the department's late afternoon announcement, she told the Associated Press: "I can't comment." On Wednesday evening, her lawyers Mark Zaid and Abbe David Lowell issued a statement that said she had neither resigned nor been told she was fired.

"When CDC Director Susan Monarez refused to

rubber-stamp unscientific, reckless directives and fire decked health experts, she chose protecting the public over serving a political agenda. For that, she has been targeted," the attorneys wrote.

"This is not about one official. It is about the systematic dismantling of public health institutions, the silencing of experts, and the dangerous politicization of science. The attack on Dr Monarez is a warning to every American: our evidence-based systems are being undermined from within," they said.

Her departure coincided with the resignations of at least three top CDC officials. The list includes Dr Debra Houry, the agency's deputy director; Dr Daniel Jernigan, head of the agency's National Center for Emerging and Zoonotic Infectious Diseases; and Dr Demetre Daskalakis, head of its National Center for Immunisation and Respiratory Diseases.
