Four BED students from Rajasthan hired a helicopter to reach their exam centre in Munsyari here as landslides caused by heavy rain have left many roads blocked in Uttarakhand.

Residents of Rajasthan's Balotra town, these students of Uttarakhand Open University had to reach RS Tolia PG College in Munsyari to take the exam.

One of these students, Omaram Jat, said, "When we reached Haldwani on August 31, we came to know that all the roads leading to Munsyari were closed due to landslides. We thought we would not be able to take our exam."



He said then they came to know about a company which provides helicopter service between Haldwani and Munsyari. However, they found that the service was temporarily unavailable due to bad weather.

The one-way fare for the helicopter ride was ₹5,200, he said.

AIADMK's Sengottaiyan removed from party posts

AIADMK senior KA Sengottaiyan, who demanded party general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami, to take back into the AIADMK fold all those who left the party, was stripped of his party posts on Saturday. A brief statement from the party said that Palaniswami has removed Sengottaiyan from the posts of (state) organisation secretary and Erode rural west district secretary.

During his "open talk" with the media in Erode, Sengottaiyan had set an ultimatum to Palaniswami to initiate steps to bring about a unification among the expelled leaders within ten days.

Reacting to the action, nine-time MLA Sengottaiyan, said, "I never expected my removal from the party posts of AIADMK Organisation Secretary and Erode Rural West District Secretary by the AIADMK General Secretary."

Speaking to reporters from his farmhouse in his native village, Kullampalayam near Gobichettipalayam on Saturday, he termed the action an undemocratic approach. He also said that he would continue his efforts to unite the expelled leaders with the party. Sengottaiyan avoided using Palaniswami's name and referred to him as 'General Secretary' as he did during his press conference on Friday.

NDA-ally AGP to move SC, seek exemption of Assam from immigrant foreigners' directive

The Asom Gana Parishad (AGP), part of the BJP-led Government in Assam, on Saturday said it will approach the Supreme Court (SC) to exempt the Northeastern State from the Centre's recent directive on immigrant foreigners. The party asserted it was in Opposition to any step that goes against the spirit of the Assam Accord, including the recent order.

The Assam Accord was signed on August 15, 1985 after a violent anti-foreigner movement, which claimed the lives of thousands.

"We have decided to file a writ petition before the Supreme Court, asking for exemption of Assam from

the order," AGP vice-president and former MP Kumar Deepak Das told a press conference here.

"Any step that seeks to dilute or is against the Assam Accord will be protested vehemently by our party," he said.

The Centre's order, issued under the recently implemented Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025, allows Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis and Christians from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who entered India on or before December 31, 2024, to stay in the country without valid travel documents, if they fled religious persecution. In a departure from the Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 that earmarked

December 31, 2014 as the entry deadline for non-Muslim immigrants to India as eligibility for granting of citizenship, the latest order extends the entry date for such immigrants by another 10 years as grounds for their non-prosecution.

Asked whether the AGP will continue to remain part of the NDA, Das said no decision has been taken in this regard.

13.79-km Shimla ropeway approved: Deputy CM

Himachal Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Mukhes Agnihotri on Saturday said that the final approval has been granted for a 13.79 km ropeway project in Shimla, terming it a step towards turning the state into a tourism hub like Switzerland.

The project to be built at ₹1,734.70 crore will take four years to complete, he said, according to a statement.

Agnihotri said the Shimla ropeway, as others like it, will help reduce traffic congestion, cut greenhouse gas emissions and will be modern, eco-friendly mode of transport. The ropeway will have three

lines, 14 sections and 13 stations, linking the state Secretariat, hospitals, schools, the railway station, and the main bus stand in the State Capital. Agnihotri said that under the Smart City Project, 19 infrastructure projects worth ₹50 crore and three more projects worth ₹25 crore would be built in Shimla by next December.

Sasikala paid ₹450 crore in old notes to buy sugar factory in TN during demonetisation: CBI

VK Sasikala, a close aide of former Tamil Nadu Chief Minister J Jayalalithaa, had allegedly paid ₹450 crore in old high-denomination currency notes to buy a sugar factory during demonetisation in 2016, according to an FIR lodged by the CBI. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) had registered the case on the Madras High Court's directions against Padmaadevi Sugars Limited (PSL) for allegedly causing a loss of ₹120 crore to the Indian Overseas Bank (IOB). The account was declared fraud in 2020. Sasikala is not named as an accused in the FIR.

The MoU and original share certificates of SV Sugar Mills Limited, which were held by the Patels and entities of the Patel Group, were seized by the I-T department during searches on November 18, 2017.

The tax department termed it benami property as the Patel Group was holding it even after the payment of ₹450 crore towards the sale of PSL, along with shares and assets, for the alleged benefit of Sasikala, who paid the amount for the purchase. The complaint alleges that Sasikala is the beneficial owner and the property in the instant case — the sugar factory of the PSL in Kancheepuram, along with the land, all the machinery, installations etc — is benami. After taking over the investigation in July, the CBI conducted searches at six locations in Tamil Nadu on August 12 in connection with the case, officials said. "The allegations in the FIR include fraudulent availing of various credit facilities from the Indian Overseas Bank, misappropriation of property, diversion of bank funds to sister concerns and unrelated entities, siphoning of funds to related parties and interest-free advances to private firms," a CBI spokesperson had said.

The IOB complaint has alleged that Hitesh Shivgan Patel, who was managing the financial affairs of PSL and was also the in-charge of Prabhat Group, had stated on oath that he had received a total of ₹450 crore in old high-denomination notes towards the sale of the sugar factory at Kancheepuram. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) regarding the sale of the factory was entered into by Hitesh Shivgan Patel, his father Shivgan Patel and brother Dinesh Patel, the complaint has alleged.
