

# Govt plans to open 2,500 more Jan Aushadhi stores

PTI ■ NEW DELHI

The Centre on Wednesday said over 5,000 Jan Aushadhi stores, which provide quality drugs at affordable rates, have been opened across the country and another 2,500 will come by 2020.

Also, the Government is planning to open at least one Jan Aushadhi store in every block.

The number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendra (PMBJK) in the country under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) has crossed 5,000-mark, Minister of State for Chemicals and Fertilisers Mansukh L Mandaviya told reporters here.

"By the year 2020, another 2,500 Jan Aushadhi stores will be opened in the country. Our aim is to have at least one such store at every block level,"

he added.

Urging the people to buy the generic medicines from the nearest Jan Aushadhi stores, the minister said the medicines sold at these stores are cheaper and consumers must take the benefit.

"Health is one sector which is on priority of our government. Government is continuously working to provide affordable treatment and medicines at cheaper prices. Today if a patient starts his/her treatment, 70 per cent of money goes on buying medicines," he said.

He further said that the demand of generic medicine is growing and Jan Aushadhi stores



across the country are serving 10-15 lakh people per day.

The Minister also said that for providing further impetus and creating awareness about use of generic medicines, it has been decided to celebrate March 7, 2019, (Thursday) as 'Janaushadhi Diwas' across India.

Under the PMBJP, the Government provides more than 800 medicines and 154 surgicals through Jan Aushadhi kendras.

# Govt has given 1st tranche of ₹2K to over 2 cr farmers under PM-Kisan: Agri Min

The Centre has transferred the first instalment of ₹2,000 each to over 2 crore farmers so far under the ambitious Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-Kisan) scheme, Agriculture Minister Radha Mohan Singh said on Wednesday.

In the Interim Budget 2019-20, the central Government had announced the PM-Kisan scheme under which ₹6,000 per year will be given in three instalments to 12 crore small and marginal farmers holding cultivable land up to 2 hectares. It promised to give the first instalment of ₹2,000 by March.

On February 24, Prime Minister Narendra Modi officially launched the scheme in Uttar Pradesh by transferring

the first tranche amount to over one crore farmers.

"Many states are seriously showing interest to implement the scheme and sending the data. So far, over 2 crore farmers have been benefitted," Singh told reporters.

Some states such as West Bengal, the minister said, are not keen to roll out the scheme and therefore not providing the data. "To such states, I only urge to keep the politics aside else the electorate will teach them a lesson," he added.

Asked about a large number of vacancies in top leadership positions at the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), Singh said the recruitment would be done in a transparent manner now as the entire process has been digitised unlike manual process earlier.

# US trade deficit surges to 10-yr high in 2018 at \$621 billion

The skyrocketing US trade deficit hit the highest level in a decade last year despite President Donald Trump's global trade offensive, according to a Government report on Wednesday.

America's trade deficit with the world jumped 12.5 per cent to \$621 billion, the Commerce Department reported, as both imports and exports rose to the highest levels ever.

And the trade gaps with China, Mexico and the European Union also reached at all-time highs even though Washington slapped tariffs on hundreds of billions in imports from its largest trading partners.

# ₹ rises for 2nd day; up 21 paise to 70.28 vs \$

PTI ■ MUMBAI

The rupee rallied by 21 paise to close at 70.28 against the US dollar on Wednesday on easing crude oil prices even as the greenback strengthened vis-a-vis other major currencies.

Forex traders said heavy buying in domestic equities and robust foreign fund inflows also propped up the rupee.

This is the second successive session of gain for the domestic currency, during which it has climbed 64 paise.

At the Interbank Foreign Exchange (forex) market, the rupee opened on a weak note at 70.60. Intra-day, it fluctuated between 70.67 and 70.25, before finally closing at 70.28, up 21 paise over its previous close.

On Tuesday, the rupee had rebounded by 43 paise to finish at 70.49 against the US dollar. Brent crude, the global oil benchmark, was trading at \$65.61 per barrel, lower by 0.38 per cent.

Meanwhile, the dollar index, which gauges the greenback's strength against a basket of six currencies, rose 0.07 per cent to 96.92.

"Dollar is trading up for the sixth consecutive session as the market awaits developments in US-China trade talks after the failure of Kim-Trump summit," said V K Sharma, Head PCG & Capital Markets Strategy, HDFC Securities.
